# **OUTLOUD AUDITION INFO**



### WHAT IS OUTLOUD?

It is a team of Granger Community Church students who serve by leading Granger Kids in high-energy worship at the Granger and Elkhart Campuses.

#### WHO CAN AUDITION?

**Elkhart:** Any student currently in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or higher who has a passion for helping others actively engage in worship.

**Granger**: Any student currently in 4<sup>th</sup> grade or higher who has a passion for helping others actively engage in worship.

### WHEN?

Wednesday, October 8, 6:30-8 p.m.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

- 1. Register online at grangerchurch.com/outloud.
- 2. Attend the auditions located this year at the Granger Campus (for both the Granger and Elkhart teams) dressed comfortably and ready to jump around! We recommend you bring a water bottle marked with your name, so you can stay hydrated.

#### WHAT WILL BE EXPECTED OF ME IF I'M ASKED TO JOIN THE TEAM?

- 1. Please be responsible and block out dates on your Planning Center Online (PCO) calendar when you are not able to serve. Please then accept or decline the invitations as they are sent to you. If your schedule changes and you can no longer serve after you have already accepted, go ahead and decline in PCO.
- 2. Arrive one hour before the first service on the day you serve (check the exact time for your campus). This allows you to rehearse with your team.
- 3. Attend the fun monthly rehearsals: Granger OutLoud usually meets the last Wednesday of each month from 6:30–8 p.m. and Elkhart OutLoud meets the last Thursday of each month from 6:30–8 p.m. NO rehearsals in December or June. This is where we learn new music, worship God and grow in our faith together. A few times a year both campuses will get together for the monthly rehearsal on a Wednesday night.
- 4. Take steps toward Christ by attending your age-appropriate ministry along with serving, either Granger Kids or Granger Student Ministries (GSM).
- 5. Exert your influence by being a role model to other students. You will exhibit appropriate, God-honoring behavior on and off the stage.
- 6. Wear your OutLoud shirt when you serve...and try to have it clean.

# WHAT ARE THE EXPECTATIONS FOR MY PARENT/GUARDIAN IF I JOIN THE TEAM?

- 1. Attend the Parent/Guardian information meeting at 7:30 p.m. during auditions: Wednesday, October 8. Please let us know if you are interested in serving as an adult supervisor for the OutLoud team once per month. This role will assist student leaders during weekend service rehearsals, guide the team to serving locations, escort the Sunday team to the cafe area in between services and ensure that all team members are picked up after services end.
- 2. Make sure your student arrives on time for weekend rehearsals and monthly rehearsals. Pick your student up in a timely fashion when they are finished serving.
- 3. Be responsible for communicating serving availability using an online scheduling system (Planning Center Online, PCO).

- 4. Be aware that your student's lack of attendance to monthly rehearsals and/or inappropriate behavior on or off the stage WILL impact your student's opportunity to serve on the OutLoud Team. Students are expected to be at all rehearsals and serve on a regular basis unless otherwise communicated ahead of time.
- 5. Give your student positive encouragement as they serve on the OutLoud Team. You can also encourage them to watch the motion videos in Planning Center Online to be able to lead with excellence.
- 6. Pray that OutLoud will truly impact kids to worship God more fully.
