WHY WE DO WHAT WE DO.

WHAT THEY'RE LEARNING...


Our programming always involves stories from the Bible, life application activities and live worship and then the content is anchored by these core, basic truths:

Preschool:

10:20–10:40 A.M.	Small Group (length varies with age) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Leaders focus on developing relationships with the kids.• Leaders guide kids through life application activities.• Prayer-focused time.

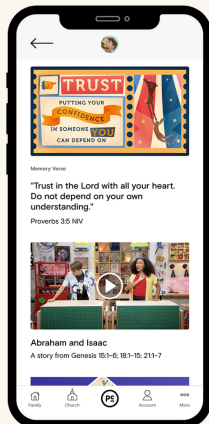

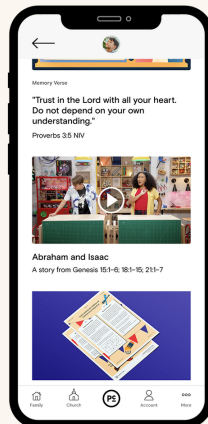

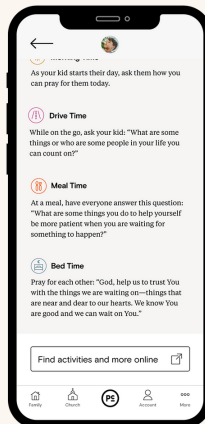
Weekly Memory Verse



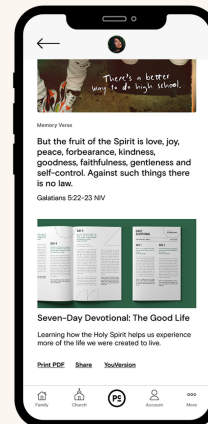
Weekly Faith Video
